Oil Theft Project – ‘Oil’II be Back’

AIM:	To prevent/reduce heating oil theft
HOW:	Profile the offences and oil supply companies. Promote Alarms, gauges, locks and forensic DNA to residents.
WHO:	Police – cross boarder and cross districts, analyst, KCC wardens, oil syndicates, CSU

Positive Parenting Project

AIMS:	Empower – network (via Linked-in) Support – best practice Assist – practical advice Install pride
HOW:	Early intervention Provide positive male role models Multi-tier support ‘Tough love’
WHO:	Police, schools, CSU, CAF, FIF, KCC, KCA, Kenward, YE, volunteers, family champions, SSPC, NHP

Designated Community Hubs/Centres – in the community, for the community

AIM:	Provide an informal drop-in community hub for the local community, – run mainly by the voluntary sector to provide preventative services, resources and information, including: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Information about healthy eating• Resources centre – including computer and internet service, education and employment opportunities• Drug and alcohol support services and information• Youth services• Mental health support services and information – raising confidence to seek help; ‘coping with life’• Crime reduction information• DAVSS/DA support and information• Restorative justice in priority neighbourhoods• Family mediators
HOW:	Identify premises

Multi-agency park sweep (Op Tumble)

AIM: Reduce/prevent youth offending and drug and alcohol addiction

HOW: Regular sweep of parks at school closing time to confiscate alcohol and make instant referrals to relevant services.

WHO: Police, youth alcohol outreach workers, Street Pastors, possibly Social Services

Referrals to Crime Reduction Initiatives (CRI)

AIM: Reduce/prevent drug and alcohol addiction and reoffending

HOW: Increase the number of referrals from agencies to CRI for drug and alcohol addiction treatment e.g. via the police through custody, Safe Town Partnership, licensees

WHO: Police, licensees and door staff, Parking Wardens, Community Wardens, CSU partners
